05 Days Technical Training Workshop:



In the month of May, training workshops of Emergency Response team (ERT) in village Dawlat Kalay was conducted successfully. Participatory approaches were used to promote maximum participation of all the members. The combination of methods including interactive lectures, group discussions, brain storming, and group work. The consultant used an experiential learning approach where the participants' existing knowledge is appreciated and built upon. The Emergency Response team (ERT) were provided with technical training on 05 mentioned groups' specific roles before, during and after any kind of emergency/ disaster. Training sessions were mainly focused on Disaster Risk Reduction (DRR) basics, Disaster Risk Management (DRM) Cycle, Early Warning system (EWS), Admin and Logistics, Information and Communication, Search & Rescue and First Aid.

Construction of Link Road:



In the month of May work has started on Link road Lowdar, it is 1200 feet's in length and is located at UC Pirkhana in Shangla. 38% work completed on link road site including 20% site clearness and 18% stone soling.

Construction of Pedestrian Bridge:



Under the DRR project in Shangla 05 pedestrian bridges (Kuz Banjar, Pedestrian bridge Bela, Pedestrian Bridge Shalawoo, Pedestrian bridge Besham Walo & Pedestrian bridge Muslimabad) are under construction.

Construction of Pathways in Shangla:



During the month of May work has been started on two pathways Located at UC Pirabad and Pirkhana in Shangla. So for 60% work has been completed on Pathway Kuzkass to Sar Shaheed & Path way Barganshal Mosque to Pyera Village. After the completion more than 2000 individuals in the area will be benefited.

Educational Kits Distribution:
